

## Ivy Tech Dual Credit Info for Precalculus

In order to qualify for Dual Credit, a student must have at least one qualifying score that meets or exceeds the following...

ACT Math 24, PSAT Math 52, SAT Math 520,  
COMPASS 66 ALGE  
ASSET 49 EALG or 48 IALG  
**ACCUPLACER 74- 120 ELEM ALG & 0-85 CLM**

We will begin offering the ACCUPLACER test on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday the week we return from Fall Break through the end of October. Students will need to report to B 101 after school for the test. You can also take it at Ivy Tech and their information is below.

Testing Center is located in G22, and is open 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday, 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Friday.

Beginning August 4th the center will start Saturday hours: 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Students can take the ACCUPLACER (or COMPASS) three times during a calendar year: students get 1 initial test and 2 retests from January 1<sup>st</sup> – December 31<sup>st</sup> of each year. With that said, three times is the **max** . . . students can take the ACCUPLACER, COMPASS, or a combination of the two tests for a **total of 3 times**.

Students can retest the following day; they cannot, under any circumstances, take the ACCUPLACER twice on the same day.

If students go to the following link, <http://www.collegeboard.com/student/testing/accuplacer/>, they can click on “Sample Questions” on the left side of the screen to see what typical ACCUPLACER questions will consist of in sentence skills (writing), reading, and math. On the right hand side of the screen, students have the option of buying an “official ACCUPLACER study app” for \$1.99 that can be downloaded to an iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch.

Students are NOT allowed to use a calculator. The Accuplacer has a calculator on the test itself, so it is not needed.

Since most all of the students only need to take a portion of the test, it should take less than an hour. If you have to take multiple parts (math and English) then it will take longer.

If a student has taken the Accuplacer or the COMPASS by way of Prosser (or maybe last year), please have them get a copy of the results and give it to Mr. Willman. He will then forward the scores to Ivy Tech.
